About Us

Begawan Biji farm was founded in 2022 to help farmers in Bali transition to chemical-free practices and increase incomes for farmers through the sale of high-quality agricultural products. We began with just one farmer and 0.44 hectares of rice and now have several farmers growing Mansur Heritage Rice on the rice fields around Begawan Biji restaurant in Bayad Village. Our aim is for farmers in the program to be able to double their incomes while restoring the health of the soil.

Meet your Experience Ambassador at the Parking at Begawan Biji, where our Rice Milling House is located.

Learn all about our regenerative Mansur Heritage Rice farming cycle – a short grain brown rice that is highly nutritious and rare due to the labour intensive efforts and only twice a year harvest, unlike hybrid/commercial rice which has 3 or up to 4 times harvest a year.

A Journey/walk through the Subak irrigation system with explanation and past the Pura Dalem (The temple of endings, transitions, and spiritual purification), to our regenerative farm.

Explore our mandala shaped permaculture gardens and regenerative farm to understand the purpose and why this is important, our compost house, and where we produce our own chemical-free compost, natural fertilisers, and botanical pest control.



Learn all about the Bali Starling and why conservation is needed. Spot free flying Bali Starling birds as well as many other bird species and biodiversity on the farm.



Visit our free-ranging laying hens and ducks, and discover how they play an essential role in our circular farming ecosystem.
